Admission and Enrollment Process

Hello New Pathfinder! We are genuinely excited to have you join our community of scholars. Please take a moment to review this document as it outlines all of the steps necessary to solidify your enrollment at BridgeValley.

Please note that in order to be fully admitted to BridgeValley, official high school transcripts, official GED/TASC transcript and/or official transcripts from all previous colleges attended must be submitted to the Admissions Office. This is vital in order to ensure that you fulfill all required coursework and do not take any classes that you may receive credit for from prior learning experiences. (In the coming weeks, watch your email for a letter from the Dean of Students Office that will give you further information.)

ACCEPTED!!! What's Next? ...

1. Testing

- Verify your testing needs to ensure accurate placement in courses.
- Schedule Accuplacer appointment or submit ACT/SAT scores to admissions:

- Note: Accuplacer, ACT or SAT scores cannot be older than 5 years.
- You must have Accuplacer, ACT or SAT scores prior to your advising appointment.

2. Advising Appointment

- Verify your admissions status to ensure there are no outstanding issues.
- Make an appointment for Registration/Advising Meeting. You will now meet one-on-one with your assigned Advisor who will help guide you on your academic journey

3. Financial Aid

- Complete the FASFA (www.fafsa.gov – BridgeValley School Code – 040386)
- Verify financial aid status. Contact Financial Aid at finaid@bridgevalley.edu
- Priority deadline (Fall – June 30th) (Spring – November 30th) (Summer – April 30th)
- Note: You must be fully admitted and degree-seeking to be eligible for financial aid

4. Orientation

- Schedule an on campus orientation via the BridgeValley website at www.bridgevalley.edu or complete the online orientation through your MyBridge account
- Reminder! Orientation is required for all students including transfer and re-admit students
