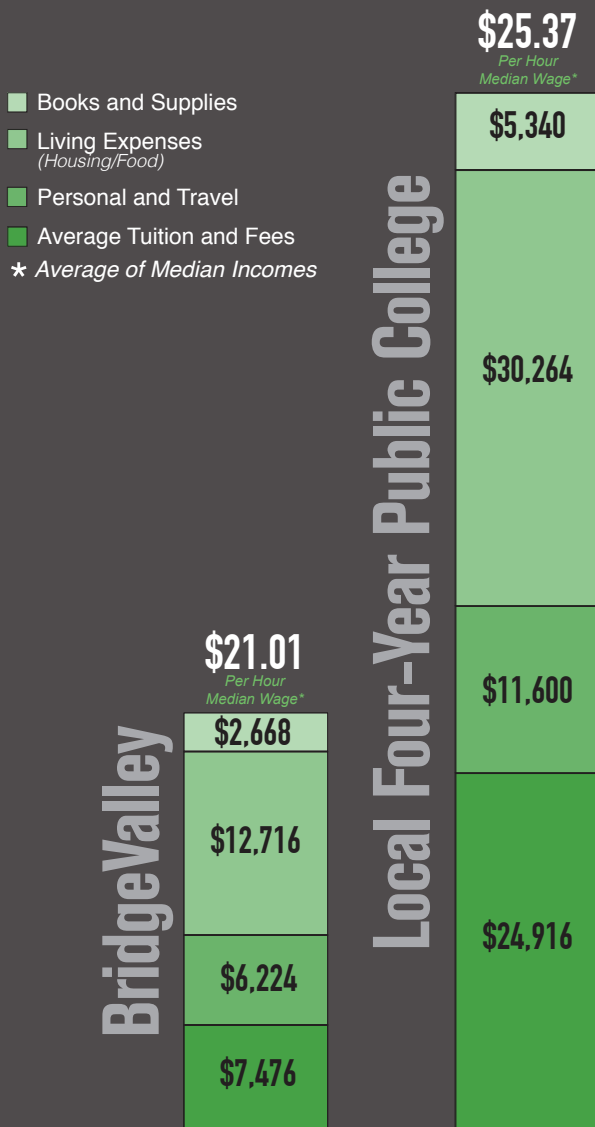


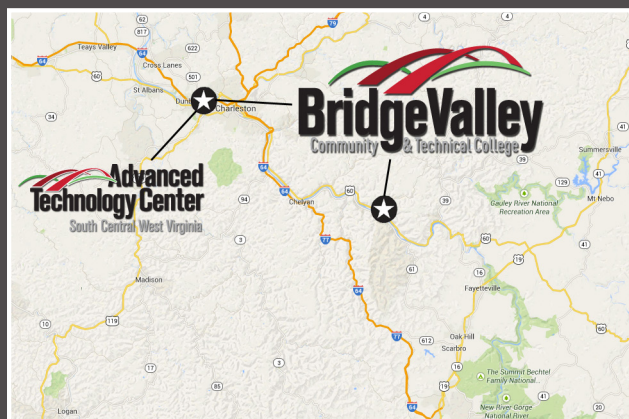
# Reduce Costs
