



EKG Technician

This comprehensive 72-hour EKG Technician Certification Program prepares students to function as an EKG Technician and to take the American Society of Phlebotomy Technician (ASPT) Electrocardiograph (EKG) Technician exam.

Additionally, students will practice with equipment and perform hands-on labs including introduction to the function and proper use of the EKG machine, the normal anatomy of the chest wall for proper lead placement, 12-lead placement and other clinical practices.

Cost: \$1,955

Includes 72-hours of classroom instruction, textbooks, national certification exam, drug screening, background check, required immunizations, and all materials and supplies. Practicum assignments are approved and arranged by the instructor.
