## Cost: \$4,000

Pipefitters typically work on large-scale projects, which means most of their employment, comes from manufacturing, industry and heavy construction. Pipefitters are in high-demand in the chemical, petroleum, and natural gas industries.

According to a 2011 Department of Labor survey of the field, pipefitters earned \$51,000 per year on average (based on 7-10 years of work experience).

Applicants must be able to pass a federal background check and a drug screen.
