

Commercial Driver's License Entry Level Driver Training (ELDT)

Our CDL classes:

- Are taught by experienced, professional truck drivers.
- Include classroom instruction, range and behind-the-wheel practice.
- Will prepare students for CDL skills test.

Classroom instruction includes (but is not limited to):

- Vehicle Safety,
- Shifting,
- Pre-trip preparation,
- Coupling and uncoupling,

Range and Behind-the-Wheel practice includes:

- Basic Control Systems
- Safe Operating Procedures
- Speed Management

- Air brakes,
- Weight distribution and proper loading,
- Preventative maintenance, and
- Map reading.
- Extreme Driving Conditions
- Backing
- Night Operations

Attendance Policy:

Due to the intensive training during classroom hours and on-the-road practice, students are expected to be in class, on time, every day. If a student misses two or more days during the program, they will be dropped from the class without a refund.

ENTRY LEVEL DRIVER TRAINING (CDL) PROGRAM OPTIONS AND FEES

CDL Class A: (includes tractor & trailer endorsement): \$5,200

- Theory, General Knowledge, state regulations, Air Brakes, and Combination Vehicles,
- Range & Behind-the-Wheel (BTW) skills,
- 4 weeks; 160 hours (8 hours/day; 5 days/week),
- Maximum # of students: 6.

CDL Class A with Pintle Hook: \$4,080

- Utility Lineman students & open enrollment
- Theory, General Knowledge, state regulations, Air Brakes, and Combination Vehicles,
- Range & BTW in utility truck
- 3 weeks; 120 hours (8 hours/day; 5 days/week)
- Does not include tractor trailer skills or endorsement
- Maximum # of students: 7

CDL Class B Box Truck (with air brakes): \$4,080

- Theory, General Knowledge, and Air Brakes,
- Range & BTW in a utility truck
- 3 weeks; 120 hours (8 hours/day; 5 days/week)
- Maximum # of students: 7

Note: If a student does not pass the skills test (administered by a third-party WV Examiner) and requires additional practice beyond the allotted time typically needed to master the skills, there will be an additional fee of \$425/day for individual practice with an instructor.

ADDITIONAL COSTS

Additional costs <u>not included</u> in the tuition and fees listed above are shown below. Some of these costs are **approximate** and should only be used as a guide.

DOT Physical (paid to the physician)	\$115.00	Due Prior to class
DMV Driving Record Report (paid to DMV)	\$11.00	Due prior to class
Class A Permit (paid to DMV)	\$65.00	Due prior to class
Driving Skills Test Fee (paid to the state examiner)	\$100.00	Due last week of class
License (paid to DMV when license is issued)	\$100.00	Due last day of class
Endorsements (paid to DMV)	\$5.00-\$10.00	Purchased with license

PAYMENT & FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

- **Self-Pay** with either cash, check, or credit card.
