

**DIRECT ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE UNIVERSITY OF CHARLESTON
and
BRIDGEVALLEY COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL COLLEGE**

I. PURPOSE

This Agreement between The University of Charleston ("UC") and BridgeValley Community and Technical College ("BridgeValley") establishes a mechanism for students of BridgeValley Community and Technical College to complete the requirements for the baccalaureate degree in programs existing at the University of Charleston. This articulation agreement allows direct transfer for BridgeValley students possessing either an A.S. or A.A.S. degree or the completion of the specified course work in a certificate degree program to UC. Additional transfer credits outside of the specific program may also be considered. **NOTE:** A program-specific articulation schedule for each UC academic program, signed by both parties, will be attached and made part of this Agreement as BridgeValley students apply for admission to UC programs.

II. GOALS

1. To provide a well-defined 2 + 2 transfer Agreement that will enable BridgeValley students the ability to plan their academic careers so as to minimize credit loss when transferring to UC to earn their baccalaureate degrees.
2. To facilitate the admission, evaluation, and enrollment of students who are pursuing an associate degree whose academic goal includes the acquisition of a baccalaureate degree.
3. To provide a course-by-course transfer Agreement between UC and BridgeValley to provide approved credit hours in UC programs for students who have earned credits and/or a degree from BridgeValley.

III. APPLICATION PROCESS

Students who wish to enroll at UC in a baccalaureate degree program as either a full-time or part-time student should apply through the University of Charleston Admissions Office.

IV. TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

1. **Admission:** BridgeValley students who wish to transfer into a baccalaureate degree program at UC must submit an application and official transcript(s) from the college(s) attended. Students will be admitted to UC provided the academic cumulative grade point average of the candidate is at least 2.25, and the student is in good academic and conduct standing. Admission into some UC academic programs may require a cumulative grade point average exceeding 2.25.

2. **Course Credit:** Courses will be considered for transfer if the courses to be transferred are equivalent or comparable to courses offered at UC, and the student's grade is "C" or better;
 - a. Transfer equivalencies are available for many BridgeValley courses;
 - b. Cooperative education courses and internships will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis;
 - c. CLEP, ACT, AP, ACE, AARTS, and other types of credits for prior learning appearing on the BridgeValley transcript are not automatically transferable. To be considered for CLEP, ACT, AP, ACE, AARTS credit, students must have an official transcript sent directly from the testing agency to the UC Admissions Office;
 - d. A letter grade of "P" is only acceptable when defined by BridgeValley as an equivalent to a "C" or better;
 - e. Grades for BridgeValley courses will not be computed as part of UC grade point average; and
 - f. All course work regardless of grade will be posted to the student's academic record for purposes of calculating eligibility for financial aid.

3. **Degree Requirements:** Students from BridgeValley are responsible for completing the following in order to receive a baccalaureate degree:
 - a. A minimum of 120 earned academic credits. A minimum of 60 hours will be transferred from BridgeValley.
 - b. Fulfillment of all requirements and outcomes of the academic program;
 - c. Demonstration of achievement of exit-level standard on all Liberal Learning Outcomes;
 - d. Cumulative UC grade point average of 2.00 (some programs require a gpa higher than 2.00); and
 - e. Demonstration of achievement of exit-level standards on discipline and program outcomes.

V. ADDITIONAL BENEFITS PROVIDED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF CHARLESTON

1. UC will post specific information for faculty, staff, and students of BridgeValley on the UC website;

2. BridgeValley students will be eligible for benefits and resources extended to U.S. Armed Forces learners including:
 - a. Credit for military training;
 - b. Post-9/11 GI Bill and Yellow Ribbon Program participation;
 - c. Scholarships for active members of the West Virginia Army and Air National Guard;
 - d. Dedicated military support services; and
 - e. Flexible military leave as required.

3. UC will list BridgeValley as a 2 + 2 member on an internal site utilized by UC learners and/or on the main website and will maintain a link that will direct learners to the BridgeValley website;
4. UC will provide literature and other information to BridgeValley to support its efforts in promoting this Agreement;
5. UC will provide BridgeValley updated degree and transfer materials for learners and graduates;
6. When possible, UC will participate in BridgeValley transfer fairs, graduate events, and faculty/staff development opportunities;
7. UC will provide a staff member as the primary contact for BridgeValley to facilitate the Agreement;
8. UC will share information regarding the aggregate number of students enrolled and courses taken by BridgeValley faculty, staff, and graduates on an annual basis; and
9. When appropriate, BridgeValley will be invited to various networking events hosted by UC.

VI. BRIDGEVALLEY COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL COLLEGE PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES

1. BridgeValley will assign a staff member as the primary point of contact to work with the identified UC contact to effectively implement the Agreement.
2. BridgeValley will work with UC to develop effective ways to share the benefits of this Agreement with faculty, staff, and graduates.
3. BridgeValley will distribute and/or make available updated degree and transfer information from UC to its learners via the BridgeValley website and through other electronic media.
4. BridgeValley will maintain a link to the UC website for students interested in obtaining a baccalaureate degree.


VII. REVISIONS TO AGREEMENT

Amendments and/or revisions to the Agreement may be made in writing at any time by mutual consent of both parties. Such amendments and/or revisions signed by authorized representatives of both parties shall be prepared in the form of an Addendum to the Agreement. The parties shall work cooperatively to review, at least annually, and to update each year as appropriate, specific items or procedures included in this Agreement. All changes made to this agreement will become effective on July 1st following the date of the Addendum, unless specified otherwise.


VIII. TERM AND APPLICABLE LAW


