Students must have a 2.0 GPA in HIS courses to be admitted directly into the History program upon transferring to West Virginia University. Students must earn a minimum GPA of 2.2 with no grade lower than a C- in all courses applied to the History Major.

Students pursuing a degree in History from West Virginia University are required to complete an academic minor.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
