

AGREEMENT


WEST VIRGINIA UNIVERSITY INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY AND BRIDGEVALLEY COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL COLLEGE

PREAMBLE: This agreement will establish an articulation agreement between BridgeValley Community and Technical College (BridgeValley) and West Virginia University Institute of Technology (WVU Tech) for students wishing to pursue baccalaureate degrees offered by the College of Business, Humanities and Social Sciences (BHSS) and who have successfully completed the first two years in associate programs at BridgeValley in accordance with the terms and conditions of this agreement. Students will benefit from reduced paperwork ordinarily associated with transfers since the agreement will assist the WVU Tech Admissions and Records Office by formalizing the educational equivalents received for courses taken at BridgeValley and specifying the remaining class work required to complete the degrees at WVU Tech.

AGREEMENT:


- Supervision of the articulation agreement at BridgeValley CTC will be by the Academic Vice President for Academic Affairs and at WVU Tech by the Dean of the College of Business, Humanities and Social Sciences. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the parties hereto agree and acknowledge that each party hereto shall maintain all control over all aspects of its academic programs, including, but not limited to admissions.
- BridgeValley students wishing to transfer to the WVU Tech baccalaureate programs must meet the minimum entrance requirements to the College of BHSS as established by WVU Tech. Such requirements may change from time to time, at the discretion of WVU Tech.
- Based upon the evaluation of such and other relevant material, a specific articulation program of study will be developed by WVU Tech, which specify what courses will remain to be taken at WVU Tech by students transferring from BridgeValley.
- This agreement shall become effective on July 1, 2015, supersedes previous agreements, and shall extend indefinitely, unless and until either party hereto gives notice of cancellation to the other party at least ninety (90) days before the effective date of the cancellation. In addition, either party hereto may cancel this agreement upon a material breach hereof by the other party hereto, with notice of cancellation to such other party.
- Each party hereto agrees to abide by any and all federal, state, and local laws, rules and regulations applicable to its activities as contemplated herein. In addition, each party hereto agrees to execute such other documents, perform such other acts and provide such other assistance, as may reasonably be required by the other party hereto to further the purposes of this agreement.
- Neither party hereto shall use in any way, shape or form, the other party's name, logo or other designation proprietary to it, or any derivation thereof, without the prior written consent of the other party.
- Except as otherwise expressly provided for herein, this agreement shall not be amended or modified, except as set forth in a document executed by duly authorized representatives of the parties hereto. This agreement shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of West Virginia. This agreement constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between the parties and supersedes any and all previous or contemporaneous agreements or understanding relating to the subject matter hereof.
- Each party hereto agrees to schedule a meeting annually to discuss any changes to its programs and curriculum that may affect elements of this agreement.


