**BridgeValley Community and Technical College**  
**and Alderson Broaddus University to Sign Articulation Agreement**

(South Charleston, WV) - BridgeValley Community and Technical College and Alderson Broaddus University will enter into a three-year articulation agreement on January 25.

The two schools have agreed upon terms that will provide a seamless transition for BridgeValley students transferring to Alderson Broaddus to continue their education and complete their four-year degrees. Students eligible to take advantage of the articulation agreement must maintain a GPA of at least 2.0 and be in good standing with BridgeValley. A maximum 72 hours of lower-division units will transfer and the final 30 units of coursework must be completed at Alderson Broaddus.
